Dear PIASS students,



Those unable to register online could do that on campus.
- New students are requested also to register as from 5<sup>th</sup> in order to get ready for the commencement of their classes on 15<sup>th</sup> February 2021
- From the 5<sup>th</sup> February, there will be a posted timetable indicating recapitulation sessions for ongoing level I and II. Please address any query related to this in your respective departments
- Ongoing students (level III, IV and V) will be communicated by their departments on their related teaching and learning plan
- While in the campus, you are obliged to follow all instructions related to the prevention of COVID-19 as indicated

As informed from the previous communiqué, kindly make sure that you have observed all requirements, and prepare well for your classes and exams. We hope that with your student card, you will be able to request for a movement pass when needed.
