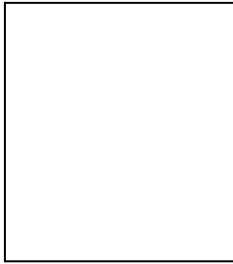

Applicants from other academic disciplines may be accepted and recommended to take particular compensatory modules.

b. Applicants should include official transcripts of every institute of higher education attended. Documents not in English or French should be accompanied by an official certified translation.

c. The university at which you have obtained a bachelor/master/postgraduate degree should be an officially recognized and accredited university
